❖ **PROJECT**

- This library-community center facility is the 3rd major joint facility that was developed and will be built using funds from Library and Parks Bond Measures approved by voters in 2000.
- The completed joint facility will enhance the library and recreation services in this area of District 6 in San José.

❖ **PROJECT ELEMENTS**

- 40,000 square foot library and community center, including a large front “sun porch” for multiple community use.

Library – 20,000 sq ft

- Living room with fireplace
- Internet café
- Technology center
- Group and quiet study areas
- Teen room
- Program room and patio

Community Center – 20,000 sq ft

- Large gymnasium
- Multi-purpose room with kitchen
- Fitness center
- Game room
- Conference room
- Locker room
- Staff offices

Common Spaces –

Internet café, program room and patio

- 2-acre Site
 - 100 surface parking spaces
 - Low-maintenance landscaping around the building
 - Trees

❖ **DESIGN**

- The building has been designed to meet the criteria of LEED **SILVER** level and will also be registered and submitted to USGBC (United States Green Building Council) for the silver level certificate.

- Thank you to the voters of Measure O and P in the November 2000 elections.

❖ **BID AND AWARD**

- Bids opened on May 29, 2008

❖ **TOTAL BUDGET**

- \$30.1 million

❖ **CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE**

- Construction is scheduled to begin in summer of 2008; completion in spring of 2010.
