



Partners in Reading Families For Literacy (FFL) Program Volunteer Job Description



Partners in Reading provides free one-to-one literacy tutoring for English-speaking adults who read or write below the ninth grade level. Adult learners with preschool-age children may also participate in the Families for Literacy program, which introduces learners and their families to the value and joy of reading together. The program includes monthly family parties with storytelling, parenting instruction, and hands-on activities. The family parties are held once a month.

Volunteers are needed once a month from to help the family literacy coordinator with family party activities.

Duties include:

- Helping with party setup (refreshments, art activities, toys)
- Helping children with arts and crafts activities during party time as directed by the family literacy coordinator
- Helping with cleanup after the party

Volunteer Qualifications:

- Must enjoy working with very young children and have a positive attitude toward children and families
- Must be reliable
