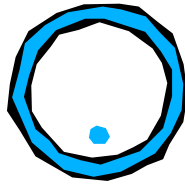


ASKING QUESTIONS-



When you ask questions before, during, and after reading, you:

- Help your child understand what the story is about.
- Encourage your child to talk.
- Share your own ideas.

Ask questions such as:

- *What do you think this story will be about?*
- *What do you think will happen next?*
- *What did you like the most about the story?*
- *Was there anything you didn't like?*
- *Who was your favorite character? Why?*
- *Was there anything you didn't understand? What?*
- *Who was telling the story? How do we know?*
- *Where did the story take place?*
